TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF INSPECTION SERVICES AT FOREIGN ABATTOIR AND PROCESSING PLANTS THAT REQUEST TO EXPORT MEAT AND PRODUCT OF ANIMAL ORIGIN TO MALAYSIA

Terms and conditions:

- 1. All establishments that request to export meat and product of animal origin to Malaysia will be subjected to inspection. The inspection includes compliance audit, review audit and inspection for verification of the noncompliance of the involved establishments.
- 2. The cost of inspection is based on 'Cost Recovery' which covers all expenses including return airfares, accommodation and in-country transportation during inspection period will be born by the exporting establishments. However, the meal and other expenses will be born by Malaysia Authority. This cost may be shared among the abattoirs and processing establishments involved in the inspection schedule. The number of establishments to be inspected, number of inspection teams and inspection schedule will be decided by Department of Veterinary Services Malaysia (DVS).
- 3. Any establishment to be inspected for the purpose of compliance or review audit will be charged with processing fee of RM5000.00.
 - 3.1 Payment may be made in the form of bank draft or telegraphic transfer to Director General of Veterinary Services Malaysia prior to inspection and notify payment to DVS.
 - 3.2 Official receipt will be issued upon payment.
 - 3.3 Processing fee is not refundable.
- 4. The Inspection Team will comprise of 3 (three) officers from DVS/JAKIM/Ministry of Health Malaysia

- 5. The validity of approval to export to Malaysia is 1 (one) year and may be extended to another 2 (two) years subjected to::
 - 5.1 Annual Performance Report of exporting establishment
 - 5.2 For Halal product establishments, Bi-annual report from Accredited Islamic Body by JAKIM in the exporting country.
 - 5.3 Review audit shall be carried out not later than the expiry of validity date. However, the approved establishments may be subjected to annual review audit.
- 6. Malaysia Authority may carry out inspection at any time within the validity period on the exporting establishment for verification on the aspect of Sanitary Phytosanitary (SPS), Food Safety and Halal.
