NFCorp chairman lodges report

KUALA LUMPUR: National Feedlot Corporation (NFCorp) chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mohamad Salleh Ismail lodged a police report against Parti Keadilan Rakyat strategy director Mohd Rafizi Ramli vesterday.

Salleh alleged that Rafizi had breached the Banking and Financial Institutions Act 1989 by revealing private and confidential banking details.

In the police report, Salleh said Rafizi had distributed banking details and credit ratings of National Feedlot Corporation Sdn Bhd, National Meat and Livestock Corporation Sdn Bhd, Real Food Company Sdn Bhd, Agroscience Industries Sdn Bhd and also the personal bank details of directors and shareholders of those companies.

He claimed that the confidential details of 21 entities had been displayed without their authorised consent.

Salleh urged the police and Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) to investigate the matter.

NFCorp had also lodged a formal

complaint to BNM against the bank that provided the information. Salleh said Rafizi's actions were slanderous.

"Rafizi had slandered my financial standings by insinuating that I was not credit worthy for loans and have taken personal loans leveraging on a government soft loan deposit.

"He also insinuated that I had specifically taken personal loans for private investments in KL Eco City when in actual fact no loan was ever taken for the investments."
