

S.O.S. from homeless canines

Chance to adopt pups and dogs at Summit Subang Jaya tomorrow

FRIGHTENED that the puppies she was caring for would end up in the pot, a Vietnamese foreign worker appealed to a business owner who visited the factory to take them away.

Being a dog lover herself, the business owner who declined to be named, turned the six puppies to animal welfare project Malaysian Dogs Deserve Better (MDDB).

"We understood her concerns when she approached us and have arranged for the puppies to be brought to our adoption drive this Sunday," said MDDB adoption coordinator Christine Lai.

She said the puppies, which had been removed from the factory in Subang, were healthy and

had been given their first vaccination.

The adoption drive will be held at the Summit Subang Jaya main entrance between 11am and 6pm tomorrow.

Lai added there would be several batches of puppies at the adoption drive including another family of five puppies living near a temple in Seri Kembangan.

"There are just too many puppies around and we really need to find them homes as only then we will be able to rescue more puppies," said Lai.

She said besides puppies, several adult dogs would also be put up for adoption.

"These adults have been vaccinated and neutered and therefore it will save those who adopt them the task of doing it," explained Lai.

She added those who wanted to drop off donations in cash and

kind could also do so at the adoption drive.

"We are also appealing for help to pay the veterinary clinic we take our rescued dogs and puppies to. Donors can also obtain their names and details from us at the adoption drive," said Lai.
