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Man recalls nearly crashing into cow near LCCT

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It was a narrow escape for a businessman who almost collided into a cow while on his way to the Low-Cost Carrier Terminal (LCCT) near the KL International Airport (KLIA) recently.

Jason Ong, 61, said he was driving to the airport at about 11pm two months ago to pick up his wife when he nearly crashed into a cow head-on near Jalan Pekekling.

"A big black cow suddenly appeared in the middle of the road. Luckily I was not driving very fast and managed to swerve to the right.

"However, the cow still grazed the side of my car," he said, adding that only the car's side mirror was damaged.

"Thank God there was no other motorists on the road at that time," he said.

Recounting the frightening experience, he said it was common to see cows by the side of the highway but never imagined he would have such a close encounter with one.

"I will definitely slow down when driving along this stretch in the future," he said.
