REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF DUCKS/DUCKLINGS FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM INTO MALAYSIA

- A. Birds : Ducks/Ducklings
- B. Country of Export : United Kingdom (Great Britain)
- C. Purpose : Breeding
- D. Regulations for importation :

1. Import Licence

The consignment of ducks/ducklings shall be accompanied by a valid import licence issued by the Director General of Veterinary Services, Malaysia or the State Director concerned permitting the importation of such ducks/ducklings into the State(s) of Malaysia.

2. Description of Birds

The consignment of ducks/ducklings shall be accompanied by a certificate containing a full description or identification of the ducks/ducklings.

3. Veterinary Certification

The consignment of ducks/ducklings shall be accompanied by a veterinary health certificate issued by a competent Government Veterinary Officer of the United Kingdom (MAFF) certifying that :-

3.1 the United Kingdom is free from fowl plague (pathogenic avian influenza) and duck plague (duck viral enteritis) for twelve (12) months preceding the export of the ducks/ ducklings.

3.2 the farm(s) of origin has been free of duck viral hepatitis for the preceding twelve (12) months of export.

3.3 the ducks/ducklings were hatched from eggs originated from an accredited pullorum free farm(s) in the United Kingdom.

3.4 the ducks/ducklings were derived from eggs hatched in an incubator which has been disinfected or fumigated prior to hatch.

3.5 the ducks/duckling were packed direct from the incubator into satisfactorily clean boxes for export and had no contact with any birds other than ducks/ducklings.

3.6 the ducks and their flock of origin have been inspected on the premises of origin by the competent Government Veterinary Officer and found free from evidence of any infectious and contagious disease, immediately prior to export.

3.7 should any outbreak of infectious or contagious diseases occurred or suspected occurred on board the aircraft, the ducks/ducklings shall be destroyed and disposed off appropriately.

4. Transportation

4.1 the consignment of ducks/ducklings shall be transported by aircraft direct to Subang International Airport, Kuala Lumpur. No stopover shall be allowed.

4.2 upon arrival in Malaysia, the ducks/ducklings shall then be taken direct to farm(s) approved by the Department of Veterinary Services, for observation for a period of 60 days by a competent officer of the Department of Veterinary Services, Malaysia.

5. Other Conditions

The Director General of Veterinary Services, Malaysia or the State Director concerned who issued the import licence shall be informed as soon as possible the date and time of arrival of the ducks/ducklings at Subang Airport.
