**REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC FOWLS,
CHICKEN, DUCKS, GOOSE, TURKEYS, GUINEA FOWLS, QUAILS
AND PIGEONS
(BUT NOT INCLUDING THE EGGS THEREOF AND DAY OLD BIRDS)**

- A. Birds : Domestic Fowls, Chicken, Ducks, Goose, Turkeys, Guinea Fowls, Quails and Pigeons
(But not including the eggs thereof and day old birds)
- B. Country of Export : Singapore
- C. Purpose : Slaughter

1. Import Licence

The consignment of birds shall be accompanied by a valid import licence issued by the Director General of Veterinary Services, Malaysia or the State Director concerned permitting the importation of such birds into the State(s) of Malaysia.

2. Description of Birds

The consignment of birds shall be accompanied by a certificate containing a full description or identification of the birds.

3. Veterinary Certification

The consignment of birds shall be accompanied by a veterinary health certificate issued by a competent veterinary officer of the Primary Production Department (PPD), Singapore certifying that :

- 3.1 the birds are bona fide Singapore birds.
- 3.2 the birds are clinically healthy and free from any sign of infectious or contagious diseases of birds prior to and at the time of export.
- 3.3 the birds came from farm(s) registered and accredited for export by the PPD and that there were no case of velogenic Newcastle disease, pathogenic avian influenza (fowl plague) and duck viral enteritis (duck plague) had occurred or diagnosed on the farm within twelve (12) months preceding export.

4. Transportation

The consignment of birds shall be transported in sealed trucks or lorries direct to the prescribed landing place or point of entry as directed by the Director General of Veterinary Services, Malaysia or the State Director concerned.
