

Kit Siang: No PAC meet over NFC

PETALING JAYA: DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang said the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) has not met since the start of investigations into the National Feedlot Corporation (NFC) scandal.

In a blog posting on Tuesday, he faulted PAC chairman Datuk Seri Azmi Khalid for not pursuing a full-scale investigation into the RM250mil issue, involving the family of Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil.

"The decision to allow the police and Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) to first complete their respective investigations is only Azmi's personal inclination.

"It cannot be the collective decision of the PAC as it has not met after the start of the police and MACC investigations," Lim said.

He said it was not right for the PAC to have nothing to show on NFC when Parliament reconvenes on March 12, adding that the PAC must set the record straight following demands by Perkasa that the Auditor-General issues a statement to clear the NFC of the scandal.
