

# 'Govt has identified ways to resolve NFC problem'

In **KANGAR**, Muhyiddin said the Government had identified steps to be taken to resolve the NFC problem.

"I discussed the matter (with Noh) several days ago along with his officers and legal adviser.

"We have a solution to this matter," he said, adding that he would discuss the suggestions with Najib before announcing them.

Muhyiddin was speaking to reporters after a meet-the-people session in Dewan Wawasan 2020 yesterday.

The NFC issue came to light in October after the Auditor-General's Report revealed that the RM250mil cattle breeding project had failed to reach its target.

Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil's husband, Datuk Seri Dr Mohamed Salleh Ismail, is NFC's executive chairman.

On Thursday, Shahrizat had announced that she was taking a three-week break.

Meanwhile, on another matter, Najib said Umno had always been targeted by PAS whenever it faced problems.

"The question is why Umno is made their punching bag when the crack is within PAS itself," he said, referring to a statement by PAS deputy president Mohamad Sabu that Barisan Nasional insiders were helping Pakatan Rakyat to win in the next general election.

However, Najib said he was not surprised by Mohamad Sabu's remarks as was he was known to give controversial statements.

On whether a roadshow by Opposition Leader Datuk Anwar Ibrahim following his acquittal of sodomy charges would affect Barisan in the coming election, Najib said it was "normal" for the opposition to do so.

"If they don't do that, what other capital do they have?" he asked.

Barisan, Najib said, was ready to face Pakatan in spite of whatever tactics they might use.
