**REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION  
OF SEMEN INTO PENINSULAR MALAYSIA**

- A Animal Species :** Cattle  
**B Product :** Semen (Frozen or Chilled)  
**C Country of Export :** Argentina, Brazil  
**D Purpose :** Artificial Insemination

**E Regulations for Importation:**

1. A certificate signed by a Government Veterinary Authority certifying that:
  - a. the semen is derived from an Artificial Insemination Centre which is under the supervision of a veterinary surgeon and is licensed by the Government of the exporting country and that the country
  - b. that the province where the said artificial insemination centre is located has been free from foot and mouth disease, rinderpest, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia for a period of six (6) months immediately preceding the collection of semen
2. A declaration by the Veterinary Surgeon in charge at the artificial insemination centre certifying that:
  - a. that the semen in the consignment is been kept in the artificial insemination centre for at least six (6) months immediately prior to export
  - b. the donor bull or bulls have been tested and found free from tuberculosis, brucellosis, compylobacteriosis, trichomoniasis, leptospirosis, bluetongue, enzootic bovine leukosis and infectious bovine rhinotracheitis (IBR)
3. An import licence issued by the Director General Services or the State Director Veterinary Services permitting the import of such semen into the State/States of Peninsular Malaysia
