Kilang proses ayam jijik ditutup 2 minggu

Bukit Mertajam: Tahap kebersihan yang hanya 34 peratus sahaja menyebabkan sebuah kilang memproses ayam di Permatang Tinggi di sini, dikenakan tindakan serta tutup dua minggu bermula semalam.

Pegawai Kesihatan Persekitaran, Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah Seberang Perai Tengah (PKDSPT), Baharudin Osman berkata, pemeriksaan pihaknya mendapati tahap kebersihan kilang itu amat mendukacitakan dan gagal mencapai piawaian dikehendaki.

"Sebagai premis yang memproses produk makanan kepada pelanggan, sepatutnya perkara ini tidak boleh berlaku.

"Oleh itu, notis penutupan 14 hari diberikan supaya pemilik dapat melakukan pembersihan dan memperbaiki infrastruktur yang rosak.

"Kita turut mengeluarkan dua kompaun mengikut Peraturan 11(1)(a) dibaca bersama Peraturan 18(a) Peraturan Peraturan Kebersihan Makanan 2009 dan mengikut Subseksyen Peraturan 9(a) Peraturan Peraturan Makanan 1985," katanya di sini, semalam.

Menurutnya, kompaun kerana gagal memastikan lantai premis dalam keadaan baik dan mudah dibersihkan, selain mengilankan produk jualan tanpa label.

SIV H1N1 VIRUS

SWINE FLU DETECTED IN LIVESTOCK

'Infected pigs show no symptoms of disease, no risk of spreading infection to humans'

KUALA LUMPUR

THE Veterinary Services Department (DVS) has detected seropositive samples of the Swine Influenza H1N1 (SIV H1N1) virus, or swine flu, in commercial livestock and wild boars via the national surveillance programme.

The department, however, said that the seropositive pig breeds showed no symptoms of disease and were not at risk of spreading the infection to humans.

The Agriculture and Food Industries Ministry, through the DVS and the Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services, had taken measures to prevent the disease from entering the country.

Among them are restrictions on the importation of pigs and pig products from infected and at-risk countries, as well as preventive measures, including monitoring and inspections at the country's main gateways.

DVS said awareness campaigns on swine flu had been launched in all states, and livestock breeders were urged to increase farm biosecurity through preventive measures, such as not visiting infected pig farms.

The swine industry has a livestock population of 1,748,547, worth some RM5 billion, being bred on 614 commercial farms, involving about 5,000 workers, it added. **Bernama**
