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New Resource Pack To Teach Compassion For Animals Among Preschoolers

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 15 — The Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) has developed an animal welfare resource pack (PSKH) to be used as a teaching and learning support material at all preschools under the Education Ministry (MOE) nationwide.

Developed in collaboration with the Agriculture and Food Security Ministry (MAFS) and the Preschool Sector of the MOE's Curriculum Development Division, the resource pack aims to instil a culture of love and care for

animals among preschoolers.

"In addition, the resource pack is also vital to shaping a culture of responsible pet ownership, especially for the younger generation in the country," it said in a statement today.

The PSKH, among others, contains four animal-themed children's songs, a video on pet care (cats), a bilingual storybook titled "Fara Loves Animals", a guide for teachers, and a "Yummy" card game.

The “Fara Loves Animals” storybook will be distributed in stages to all preschools from this year until 2026.

In addition, the resource pack will be uploaded to the DVS website and the Curriculum Development Division’s portal as well as the BPK-SumberKu Repository.

Earlier, MAFS deputy secretary-general Datuk Badrul Hisham Mohd said that the initiative could provide early education to students at the preschool level so they will be compassionate towards animals and foster a loving society towards all living beings.

“I would like to suggest to the MOE that educators in all schools guide students to love and care for animals with compassion to prevent neglect and cruelty towards animals.

“When there are cases that go viral about cruelty to animals involving teenagers and school students, it is very concerning because such actions should not occur among underage students in the country,” he said during the launch of the PSKH at SK Putrajaya Presint 16(2) today.-

PUTRAJAYA: Jabatan Perkhidmatan Veterinar (DVS) telah membangunkan pek sumber kebajikan haiwan (PSKH) bagi digunakan sebagai bahan sokongan pengajaran dan pembelajaran di semua prasekolah di bawah Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) seluruh negara.

Dibangunkan dengan kerjasama Kementerian Pertanian dan Keterjaminan Makanan (KPKM) dengan kerjasama Sektor Prasekolah, Bahagian Pembangunan Kurikulum KPM, pek sumber

tersebut bertujuan menerapkan budaya menyayangi haiwan dalam kalangan murid prasekolah.

"Selain daripada itu, pek sumber itu juga penting untuk membentuk budaya pemilikan haiwan yang bertanggungjawab terutamanya bagi generasi muda dalam negara," menurut DVS dalam kenyataan pada Khamis.

DVS memaklumkan, PSKH yang terdiri daripada bahan fizikal dan digital, antara lain

mengandungi empat lagu kanak-kanak bertemakan haiwan, video pengendalian haiwan kesayangan (kucing), buku cerita bertajuk "Fara Sayang Haiwan" yang diterbitkan dalam dwibahasa serta panduan untuk guru dan kad permainan "Yummy".

Buku cerita "Fara Sayang Haiwan" akan turut diagihkan ke semua prasekolah bermula tahun ini hingga 2026 secara berfasa.

Selain itu, pek sumber berkenaan akan dimuat naik di laman web DVS dan portal Bahagian Pembangunan Kurikulum serta Repositori BPK-SumberKu.

Terdahulu, Timbalan Ketua Setiausaha KPKM, Datuk Badrul Hisham Mohd ketika berucap dalam majlis peluncuran PSKH di Sekolah Kebangsaan Putrajaya Presint 16(2), di sini, berkata, inisiatif berkenaan dapat memberikan pendidikan awal mengenai sikap ihsan kepada haiwan, seterusnya menjadi masyarakat yang penyayang sesama makhluk.

"Saya ingin mencadangkan kepada pihak KPM agar warga pendidik di semua sekolah dapat membimbing pelajar supaya cintakan dan jaga haiwan dengan penuh kasih sayang bagi mengelakkan berlakunya pengabaian dan

penganiayaan kepada haiwan.

"Apabila ada kes-kes yang diviralkan tentang penganiayaan kepada haiwan melibatkan remaja dan pelajar sekolah, sesungguhnya sesuatu yang amat membimbangkan kerana perbuatan ini sepatutnya tidak berlaku dalam kalangan pelajar di bawah umur di negara ini," katanya. - [ASTROAWANI](#)
