

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF FERTILIZER CONTAINING ANIMAL MANURE INTO MALAYSIA**

**1.0 Product** : Fertilizer containing manure

**2.0 Type of Animals** : Chicken

**3.0 Purpose** : Fertilizer

**4.0 Country of Export** : Any Country

**5.0 Regulation for Importation** :

### **5.1 Import Permit**

The consignment of fertilizer shall be accompanied by a valid import permit issued by Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services (MAQIS) permitting the importation of such product into Malaysia.

### **5.2 Veterinary Health Certificate**

The consignment of fertilizer shall be accompanied by an official Veterinary Health Certificate in English issued by competent Veterinary Authority of the exporting countries certifying that;

5.2.1 The country of origin has been continuously free from Newcastle disease and highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) during the preceding 28 days prior to export.

5.2.2 The poultry manure referred to in the certificate has been subjected to one of the following processes (stating which method was adopted):

5.2.2.1 composted for at least 150 days with frequent introduction of oxygen in order to achieve and maintain a temperature in excess of 76°C for at least 7 days or dried by forced air blown across the conveyor belts carrying fresh dung. or

5.2.2.2 moist heat treatment for 30 minutes at 56°C; or

5.2.2.3 heat treatment where the internal temperature throughout the product reached at least 74°C; or

5.2.2.4 any equivalent treatment that has been demonstrated to inactivate avian influenza viruses;

5.2.3 The processed material is granulated and dried to final moisture content of not more than 20% for household use or 30% for farm use.

5.2.4 The material immediately after processing, has been packed into clean water proof bags labeled with particulars of the farm or facility of production, the content,

intended use, net weight and moisture content and then sealed tight to prevent leakage.

5.2.5 After processing every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination of the product with potential source of pathogens.

### **5.3. Labelling Requirement**

5.3.1. The packing/bag must be clearly marked with the words FERTILIZER and STRICTLY NOT FOR USE IN ANIMAL FEEDING

5.3.2. The product package must be also clearly labeled with;

5.3.2.1. Name and address of the manufacturer

5.3.2.2. Batch/lot number

### **5.4 Technical Committee of Importation Microorganism and Organic Matter (MOBO) approval**

5.4.1 The application of importation needs to go through the Technical Committee of Importation Microorganism and Organic Matter (MOBO) under the Department of Agriculture for approval before importation. This requirement is not applicable for importation of samples for the committee evaluation.

### **6.0 Transportation and Landing Place**

Each consignment of animal fertilizer imported into Malaysia shall be carried by ship or aircraft or any vehicle direct to the prescribed landing place or any other port in Malaysia.

### **7.0 Inspection and Verification**

Each consignment of the product imported into Malaysia shall be subject to inspection by the authorized officer of MAQIS at the point of entry in Malaysia.

### **8.0 Sampling**

Samples of the fertilizer shall be taken by the MAQIS enforcement officers in charge at the point of entry in Malaysia for testing as and when deemed necessary

### **9.0 Suspension of Import**

The Director General of Veterinary Services Malaysia at any time when deemed necessary suspend the importation of the fertilizer containing animal products either temporarily or permanently in the event of disease outbreaks or suspected disease outbreaks or in case of importation in contravention of the above requirements

## **10.0 Right to Amend Import Regulations**

The Director General of Veterinary Services Malaysia reserves the right to amend the above regulations at any time as he may deem necessary.

## **11.0 Other condition**

The consignment of product shall comply with all applicable laws and with all directives, orders, requirements and instructions given by any authority competent to do so under any applicable law in Malaysia.

Complying to this import requirement does not exempt the imported consignments from other requirements set by other Malaysian competent authority.
