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Kuching To Host First-ever Malaysian World Veterinary Poultry Congress 2025

Kuching has been named as the host city for the 23rd World Veterinary Poultry Association Congress (WVPAC 2025), marking the first time the global event will be held in Malaysia.

The congress, with the theme Sustainable Healthy Poultry for a Healthier World, is scheduled to take place from October 6 to 10, 2025, at the Borneo Convention Centre Kuching (BCKK).

The event will bring together over 1,500 delegates from more than 50 countries,

including 19 leading international speakers, and generate a total economic impact of over RM9.8 million (US\$2.3 million) for Sarawak.

WVPAC 2025 will serve as a key platform for sharing cutting-edge research and best practices to strengthen the resilience of global poultry production. In addition to the conference, an exhibition will showcase the latest innovations and services in poultry health and production.

However, officials

emphasised that the true legacy of the congress will be the knowledge exchange and partnerships it fosters.

Terengganu Perkenal Mekanisme Baru Elak Kegagalan Program Lembu Pawah

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KUALA TERENGGANU, 10 September – Kerajaan Terengganu memberi jaminan bahawa program pembangunan sektor penternakan yang sedang dilaksanakan tidak akan mengulangi kegagalan sistem lembu pawah sebelum ini, sebaliknya diperkenalkan dengan mekanisme lebih telus, berstruktur dan berkesan.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pertanian, Industri Asas Tani, Keterjaminan Makanan dan Komoditi negeri, Dato' Dr Azman Ibrahim berkata,

kerajaan negeri telah memperoleh dana khas untuk membangunkan industri penternakan rakyat menerusi pendekatan baharu.

Menurutnya, dana tersebut tidak diagihkan dalam bentuk wang tunai, sebaliknya digunakan bagi membeli induk lembu baka berkualiti yang telah disahkan bunting atau Pregnant Tested In Calf (PTIC).

“Kerajaan bukan hendak membela lembu ini,

sebaliknya mengagihkan induk baka kepada penternak supaya industri dapat berkembang.

“Penerima akan diikat dengan akujanji dan komitmen tertentu. Dalam tempoh tiga tahun, seekor anak lembu perlu dipulangkan semula kepada Jabatan Veterinar. Tidak kisahlah anak yang keberapa, tetapi induk dan anak-anak lain adalah milik penternak selagi hayat lembu berkenaan,” jelasnya dalam satu kenyataan hari ini.

Beliau menegaskan, Jabatan Veterinar akan memantau pelaksanaan program itu bagi memastikan induk baka tidak dijual, disembelih atau disalahgunakan.

Katanya, strategi tersebut diyakini mampu membangunkan semula industri penternakan negeri serta menjamin keberkesanan bantuan yang diberikan.

“Memang hasrat asal saya adalah untuk beri terus kepada rakyat. Namun, manusia perlu diikat dengan komitmen supaya mereka benar-benar bersungguh. “Jika diberi tanpa syarat, sejarah kegagalan lalu mungkin berulang,” tambah beliau-[TRDI.MY](https://www.trdi.my)
